Terms and Conditions

Safety - Your child will be residing in the protected enclosed environment of Churchill College, one of the thirty-one Colleges of the world-class University of Cambridge, and will not be permitted to go out unless he/she is accompanied by one of our staff members. Accompanying Chaperone Teachers and our own Mentors (all Cambridge University Undergraduates or Graduates) are also resident near our students. We understand parents' concerns for the absolute safety of their children. This is naturally of paramount importance to us. Relatives visiting Cambridge during the programme may only see the child by prior arrangement with us in the light of our very full timetable.

Fees/Insurance - Parents are reminded that we strongly recommend that participants be fully covered by a comprehensive travel policy and a private medical insurance policy. For example, your insurance policy should include cover against unexpected illnesses just prior to departure or visiting a doctor during the period of stay in Cambridge. This Policy should cover all eventualities as our fees are non-refundable.

Medical Care - We engage an experienced Matron on our Programme who will look after your child if there is any minor illness. The Matron will take full responsibility for administering medication such as paracetamol, cough mixture, antihistamine, eye drops etc. normally sold over the counter for treatment of minor ailments (always taking into account medical information you have supplied to us on the Application Form). However, in the case of anything considered serious by our Matron, doctors and a world-class hospital are located in Cambridge and your child would be taken to see them. Parents hereby consent to medical treatment prescribed as essential by General Practitioners or hospital doctors. All medical and travel costs incurred are payable by the parents and reclaimed from their travel/medical insurance policy.

Mobile phones - Our Programme is a very intensive course, and students are kept very busy either in class, tuition or engaged in activities from 9 am to 9 pm. The best time for parents to ring is between 7-8 am or 1-2 pm **UK time**. Parents please do not telephone during lesson times or after 10:30 pm UK time when our students should be in bed, not using their phones for calls or computer games. Lack of adequate sleep will cause the children to be ill or unable to concentrate in class. If this happens, we may have to resort to confiscating their mobile phones.

Standards of Behaviour - High standards are expected both in College and outside. If, in the unlikely event, there is severe misbehaviour, particularly involving health and safety, in the opinion of the Cambridge Programmes Management and Staff and in consultation with the accompanying teachers, the child would be repatriated to his/her home country at Parents' expense.

Flight Arrangements - Cambridge Programmes Ltd (CPL) takes the safety of children on the flights very seriously indeed.

For students from Australia, Hong Kong and People's Republic of China - There are 3 methods of travel to Cambridge.

1. Under the supervision of a teaching staff member from their own school. The cost of the teacher's air-fare is shared between the students if the school does not cover this cost. CPL pays for the supervising teacher's full-board accommodation in the UK.
2. Under the supervision of a Chaperone staff member arranged by CPL. The cost of the Chaperone's air-fare is shared between the students. CPL pays for the Chaperone's full-board accommodation in the UK.
3. Under the care of their parents or another family member. It is the full responsibility of the child's parents to bring them to Cambridge to arrive between 5 and 6 pm on the first day even if they are travelling on the recommended flight. It is NOT possible for CPL staff to meet private participants at the airport, nor is it possible for them to travel on the private coaches to Cambridge.

For students travelling on their own from any other countries - CPL will make special arrangements to collect them from the Airport (extra travel expense may apply)

Arrival - staff members of CPL will meet the recommended flight and take the accompanied students to Cambridge on private coaches.

Departure - Children will be escorted to Heathrow Airport to catch the recommended flight on the last day by their accompanying teachers or the Cambridge Programmes Chaperone. Any parent who wishes to make alternative travel plans **must** collect their child from College at 2:30 pm on the last day. Our Programme officially ends at **2:30 pm on Saturday 24th August** after they have had a farewell lunch with their assigned Mentor.

Website - From time to time, we may post photos and videos of the Programme on our website. If you would prefer your child's photo not to appear, would you please let us know in writing. This would also apply to photographs in brochures or leaflets.

U.K. Entry Visa - Please check up-to-date information on the UK Border Agency website. If required, we will provide professional assistance in completing the UK Border Agency Application Form for a Visiting Visa and supply all the necessary documentation evidencing acceptance on our Programme but can take no responsibility if the Visa Application is not successful. The fee for this service is £100 (please add this to the Programme Fee).
